## DCSD Bring Your Own Device: Student/Parent Agreement

The use of personal technology devices on the Deerfield Community School District network is a privilege that should be used to support learning appropriate for school. Parents permitting their child to use personal technology devices in accordance with this agreement while on Deerfield Community School District property, must read, sign, and return this agreement to the school.

- 1. Acceptable devices that we believe will increase the productivity of our students: laptops, netbooks, and Chromebooks.
- 2. The student is responsible for keeping his or her own device in his possession or properly securing it, at all times. District personnel are not responsible for the security or condition of student's personal property.
- 3. The student is responsible for the proper care of personal technology devices, including all maintenance and repair, replacement or modifications, and software updates necessary to effectively use the device.
- 4. The district reserves the right to confiscate and/or inspect a personal technology device if there is reason to believe it was used to violate policies, administrative procedures, school rules, or for general misconduct.
- 5. Violations of this agreement may result in a temporary or permanent loss of privilege to use personal technology in school, and could also involve disciplinary or legal action.
- 6. The student must comply with a teacher's request to a) refrain from using a device, b) verify or display the authentication login screen, or c) power down (turn off) the device.
- 7. The student may not use any devices to record, transmit or post photos or video of a person without his knowledge and consent. Images, video, and audio files recorded at school may not be transmitted or posted at any time, without the expressed permission of a district faculty member for instructional purposes.
- 8. The student should only use personal technology devices with consent and under the direct supervision of a district faculty member and in classroom settings.
- 9. All faculty, staff, student and guest users are required to access the Internet via the district's filtered network.
- 10. Students have no rights of privacy while personal electronic devices are connected to the district network.
- 11. By participating in the DCSD BYOD program, the student is declining the DCSD 1:1 Chromebook program and will not be issued a Chromebook.
- 12. Every student is expected to have their charged device at school EVERY day. Failure to do so will require the student to check out a Chromebook from the IMC.

Possession of a personal electronic device by a student is a privilege, which may be forfeited by any student who fails to abide by the terms of this agreement, or otherwise engages in misuse of this privilege. Students violating this agreement are subject to discipline and/or confiscation of the device, and enrollment in our DCSD 1:1 Chromebook program.
