The DMS Music Department is excited to provide the opportunity to take a group of middle school music students to see the hit Broadway musical **SCHOOL OF ROCK** in Chicago. The trip will be on Wednesday, November 15th, 2017.

Andrew Lloyd Webber, the composer who wrote *Phantom of the Opera* and *Cats*, is back with a new heart-stirring hit. SCHOOL OF ROCK is a New York Times Critics' Pick and "an inspiring jolt of energy, joy, and mad skillz!" (Entertainment Weekly). Based on the hit movie, this hilarious new musical follows Dewey Finn, a failed, wannabe rock star who decides to earn some money by posing as a substitute teacher at a prestigious prep school. There he turns a class of straight-A students into a guitar-shredding, bass-slapping, mind-blowing rock band. While teaching these pint-sized prodigies what it means to truly rock, Dewey falls for the school's beautiful, but uptight headmistress, helping her rediscover the wild child within. Due to bus and ticket constraints, we are only able to bring 47 students. If more than 47 students sign up for the trip, seats will be assigned by random lottery with the remaining students being placed on a waiting list.

The cost for the whole trip, including coach bus, downtown Chicago tour, lunch at the Rainforest Café, and ticket is \$70.00. Students will also need to bring money for dinner – we will stop at the Belvedere Oasis – on the drive home. Students may use money from their band or choir accounts to pay for part/all of their trip. Since we will see a matinee show, students will miss most of the school day. They are responsible for any class-work and homework that will be missed. *Student will not be allowed to go on the trip if they are failing any classes (student cannot have more than 1 "D") or in any disciplinary/behavioral trouble – even if they have paid for the trip. They will only get a refund only if another student can take the space/ticket. Students will be removed from the trip if they are in any academic and/or behavioral trouble on or after Friday, November 3rd until the date of the show.*
