

Hey DMS Band Students and Parents!

The DMS Band will be traveling once again this year to perform at the 2018 Kalahari Band Festival on Wednesday, May 23rd at the Kalahari Resort in Wisconsin Dells. This is a very popular Middle School-level Band Clinic comprised of other MS Bands from around the Midwest. We will perform, listen to other groups, receive help from clinicians, and also SWIM AND PLAY! This will be a great celebration of a year of hard work and wonderful music making. On that Wednesday, students will go to classes for 1st period, and then we will pack up our supplies and head to the Dells for the rest of the day.

The cost of the trip is \$29 per student. This fee covers transportation, performance, clinic, park passes, and a pizza lunch. The Deerfield Music Boosters are donating funds to pay for over half the total cost of the trip, which helps keep the cost this low. Payments can be done with cash, check made out to "Deerfield Schools" or with money in your student's Band Account (from fundraising). Students may choose to pay for more food out-of-pocket; there are many concession areas at the park if you wish to purchase more food. *If you are in need of financial assistance, please let me know – there are funds available to help. T-shirts are available (optional) that will have our school's name on the back! T-Shirts are completely optional, but a fun memento of our experience. They will be a nicer "performance" fabric this time and each shirt is available in red. They will have "11th Annual Band Festival at the Kalahari" on the front and "Music expresses that which cannot be said and on which it is impossible to be silent." – Victor Hugo on the back. The shirts will also have all the school's names listed. I will not be requiring students to purchase the shirts (we will not be using them as a group), but purchase a shirt if you would like. T-shirts are an additional \$11 (or \$14 if adult 2XL or 3XL size). Please return the attached order form with the permission slip if you would like one.

OTHER INFORMATION

DRESS – I would like students to dress nicely for our performance, similar to what we would wear for a concert. They will need to bring a change of clothes for after the park.

CHAPERONES: I will be looking for a couple of parents who would be willing to help chaperone this trip. Your duties would be to ride the bus with us, help supervise the kids while they were in the parks, and help be a "roadie" for our performance. I have two free "spectator" passes for adult chaperones in street clothes to observe in the water park/theme park. Please e-mail me if you are interested. If more than two people are interested, we will use a lottery system to choose who gets the free passes. Other chaperones would have to pay \$10 for an "observer" pass. If you plan on swimming or doing theme park activities, you also must pay the \$29 (which also includes the pizza dinner). Adults observing (whether using the \$10 waterpark or free theme park passes) can preorder the \$9 pizza dinner token, or just find some food at the park itself. *Spectators MUST remain in street clothes*. In your e-mail, please indicate: Water Park, Theme Park, <u>Observing</u> Water Park, or <u>Observing</u> Theme Park. (Don't send in any chaperone payments yet – I will contact you via e-mail about that).

PIZZA: Each paying participant will receive a token for a slice of pizza and a soda. This year we will also have carrots and ranch dip available! If there are special dietary needs that need to be taken into consideration, please let Mr. Petersen know.

Our Performance:

We will be performing at 11:30 p.m. in the Kalahari Convention Center. Our performance is FREE and open to the public. Feel free to drive up in the afternoon to watch our performance and clinic and support us! Our performance will also be broadcast live on the internet, so you can watch from home. I will send out details about this when we get closer to the Festival.

What I need from you:

- Return the permission slip with a **payment for \$29** (plus additional for optional t-shirts).
- Indicate if your child would like to do the WATER PARK or the INDOOR THEME PARK

*Water park students CAN access the theme park, but must pay for each activity. Theme park students cannot enter the water park.

• Contact Mr. Petersen if you would like chaperone the trip – indicating what type of pass you would like and if you would like the pizza token.
