### BANK OF DEERFIELD SCHOLARSHIP

The Bank of Deerfield Scholarship is offering (2) **§1,500** scholarships to be used for the school year following high school graduation. The recipients of this scholarship will receive the award after the following two conditions have been met:

- 1. Successful completion (as a full-time student) of one semester of college.
- 2. Proof of registration for a second semester of college (as a full-time) student.

Complete the **general application for local scholarships**, and **respond to the following question**, in one or more double spaced typewritten page(s):

### **Deerfield Chamber of Commerce Scholarship**

Seniors, if you are attending a two or four year school next fall, the Deerfield Chamber of Commerce is offering \$500 in Scholarship money. Students are encouraged to apply.

All applications will be reviewed and the recipient will be chosen by the Deerfield Chamber of Commerce.

- Students with any career path or major are encouraged to apply.
- The scholarship will be paid in this way:
- 2 year or 4 year program paid at the end of 1<sup>st</sup> year.

#### **Application Process:**

- 1. Complete the general application for local scholarships.
- 2. <u>Submit two letters of recommendation</u>. One should be from a high school teacher and the other from an employer. If you do not have an employer reference, use a professional reference. Note: an employer reference is preferred. The professional reference could be another teacher, someone you worked with in a volunteer situation, a coach...(not a family member). You might want to review the "Reference Writer" sheet attached, and give it to the person you are asking to write the letter.
- **3.** Choose one of the following three essay questions. Responses must be no more than two pages with a 14 font.

Question #1: Select a business or service in Deerfield and explain the importance of that business/service in the community; how it affects the community and what skills are required for its employees or volunteers. How would you benefit by working for/with this company and how would they benefit from having you work for them?

Question #2: Your dream is to start your own business. Describe what that business would be, and create a business plan that will illustrate how you will start the business and what you will need to do to be successful and how to achieve that goal.

Question #3: Do you have an idea for a fundraiser or have you participated in a fundraiser in the past? Describe what it is and how you would implement the event. What will you need to do or who else would you need to involve to make this a successful event? Who would you raise money for and why? (It doesn't need to be a Deerfield beneficiary.) Or if you have participated in one in the past, what was it and what made it so successful? What was your participation and how can you improve on this in the future?

## Criteria for DEA Child Scholarship

- 1) The children of DEA members (or former members retired from the Deerfield School District) are eligible to apply for a scholarship in the amount of \$300.
- 2) A student will be eligible to apply for this scholarship during his/her senior year in high school only. They will be eligible for the scholarship award one time only.
- 3) To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must be attending either a 2 or 4 year college or more.
- 4) A high school transcript must be provided by the student, with a GPA of 3.00 or higher, any time after the end of the first semester of his/her senior year in high school.
- 5) The application must be filled out by the student and returned by April 8 of his/her senior year. No application will be considered after that date.
- 6) All applications must be typed and edited in a professional manner.
- 7) Two letters of recommendation must accompany the application. One letter must be from a teacher, counselor, or administrator employed by the school you attend. The other must be from a member of your community who is not employed by any school district. Neither letter of recommendation may be from a family member.
- 8) After the first semester/grading period of college, the student must provide a transcript indicating a 2.75 GPA, or higher, to receive the scholarship. The student must also provide verification of enrollment for the second semester. (These two items must be provided by March 15 or the scholarship will be void.) The scholarship will be paid after the completion of these requirements.
- 9) This scholarship is available to all students who meet the criteria. All applications will be reviewed and evaluated by the DEA Scholarship Committee. Only applications which meet all criteria will be considered for this scholarship.
- 10) If you want your scholarship to be presented at your schools awards program, it is your responsibility to notify the person in charge of that program, and to find a person to present the award for you.

#### DEERFIELD EDUCATION ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP

The Deerfield Education Association values the future of education. Because of this, we are awarding (1) \$500 scholarship to a Deerfield High School graduate who is entering the field of education. The scholarship will be awarded in the second semester of the student's freshman year of college.

- 1. Successful completion (as a full-time student) of one semester
- 2. Proof of registration for a second semester (as a full-time student)

The recipients should submit verification of the two criteria to the Guidance Office at the beginning of second semester to request payment of award.

### **Scholarship Background**

This is similar to another African proverb: "It takes a village to raise a child." When we help and care for each other, everyone benefits, especially children.

The Deerfield community has long been known for supporting young people.   - a. "What community-supported activities did you participate in growing up and how have they helped you?" (this can be a community outside of Deerfield)
  - b. "As you become an adult what skills or talents could you give back to a community where you live to offer a 'helping hand' to younger children?"

## **Noll Family Scholarship**

Formerly the James and Dolores Noll Memorial Scholarship. The scholarship was established to honor our parents and their commitment to education and community service. Upon Barb Noll Callahan's retirement from Deerfield Schools it was decided by the family to establish this scholarship for Deerfield High School graduating seniors, who have committed to service in their community and continuing education.

A \$1,000 scholarship is being offered.

Students must be attending either a 2 or 4 year college in the fall. All seniors are eligible to apply.

#### **Qualifications:**

- Complete the general application for local scholarships.
- Complete one page essay, answering the following questions:
  - 1. What did you learn from your step-it-up project?
  - 2. Why are you deserving of this scholarship?
- Deerfield senior in the Class of 2025.
- Two letters of recommendation one from a Deerfield High School employee and one from a community organization member.
- Applicants should be attending a 2 or 4 year school in the fall after graduation and need not be honor students.

## Wings Over Wisconsin Scholarship

Seniors attending an approved post secondary school next year are eligible to apply. Seniors entering the following areas of study might have an advantage over others:

Education Veterinary Science Forestry
Agriculture Agriculture Business Conservation

This is **a \$500 scholarship** and will be awarded after successful completion of the first semester of post high school work as a full-time student.

- 5. What are your plans for the future, and how will you utilize the degree you are looking to pursue?

# The John Polzin Memorial Scholarship

The John Polzin family is offering (2) \$500 scholarships to high school seniors to be used for post-secondary education. The scholarship will be selected by the Deerfield High School Scholarship Committee and awarded in the second semester of the student's freshman year.

# FIRST STEP FORWARD 4-YEAR DEGREE S.T.E.M SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship will award one student, pursuing a Degree in a S.T.E.M major with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher and a STEM GPA of 3.5 or higher, an award of **a \$1,000 scholarship.** Student should be pursuing any STEM Major including science, computer science, math, engineering. The scholarship will be awarded in two awards of \$500.

To apply for the award, the student must submit the following:

- 1) Complete the general application.
- 2) Submit two letters recommendation, with at least one of them from a DHS instructor.
- 3) High School Transcript with a 3.00 GPA or higher and a 3.5 GPA or higher in STEM Classes.
- 4) Submit a written essay answering "What have I done in the past that makes me qualified to receive this scholarship?" Include a statement of purpose for receiving the scholarship including examples, personal goals and career aspirations.

# FIRST STEP FORWARD ASSOCIATE DEGREE SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship will award one student, pursuing a 2 year Associate Degree with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher, an award of a \$1,000 scholarship. The scholarship will be awarded in two awards of \$500.

To apply for the award, the student must submit the following:

- 1) Complete the general application.
- 2) Submit two letters of recommendation, with at least one of them from a DHS instructor.
  - 3) High School Transcript with a 2.00 GPA or higher.
