

Deerfield 8th Grade School Supply List

Please purchase these specific items by the beginning of the school year so that students can get started on the right foot. School supplies are much less expensive in late summer, so parents are strongly encouraged to purchase extra supplies to be used later in the school year. You may also want to think about having a set of supplies at home so that all materials do not need to travel back and forth daily (think calculator, paper, pencils, ruler, pens). Furthermore, we encourage students to label their supplies so they are easy to identify if misplaced. If you are having financial concerns, please contact the school before class starts so that your child can begin the first day with the supplies needed.

BINDERS/FOLDERS
<ul style="list-style-type: none">● 1 large 3-ring binder (Trapper Keeper type or open binder)● 1 folder for Exploratory Classes● 6 folders, 1 for each of these: math, science, social studies, language arts, literature and health
NOTEBOOKS/INDEX CARDS
<ul style="list-style-type: none">● 4 notebooks: labeled science, language arts, literature and health● 1 graph-ruled paper notebook (math)
WRITING INSTRUMENTS
<ul style="list-style-type: none">● *Pencils with erasers – 4 dozen #2 pencils (teacher keeps 2 dozen, student keeps 2 dozen)● 1 set of Crayola markers (10 pk.)● 1 set of colored pencils (12 pk.)● *1 set of Expo dry-erase markers (4pk. chisel tip)
CHOIR STUDENTS
<ul style="list-style-type: none">● 1 black 3-ring binder and a pencil to keep in the binder
TECHNOLOGY NEEDS
<ul style="list-style-type: none">● 1 scientific calculator (not graphing)● 1 pair of headphones or earbuds
OTHER ITEMS
<ul style="list-style-type: none">● 1 zipper pencil case, 3-hole punched● *1 box of kleenex/tissues*● *1 pack of glue sticks
