

Deerfield Schools Continued Learning Plan Guide

Our continued learning plan for students will begin on Wednesday, April 1st.

Continued Learning Goals

- 4K-Gr. 8 will provide supplemental and enrichment online instruction. The focus will be on maintaining skills and keeping students engaged in learning. This work will not be graded, nor included on report cards. Work will be monitored and modified by special education staff to ensure support and equity of learning to the extent possible.
- Gr. 9-12 will hold Quarter 4 classes as scheduled via online instruction. The focus will be on teaching essential learning outcomes. This work will be graded in Skyward as usual, but students will receive a final grade of pass/fail since we cannot ensure equity of resources for all students. The grade point average will be put on hold and not impacted by the pass/fail grades. It will allow students to continue earning needed credits towards graduation requirements. Work will be monitored and modified by special education staff to ensure support and equity of learning to the extent possible.

Teacher Work Day

- 7:30am-3:30pm (Teachers will be checking and responding to emails throughout the day.)
- Teacher Access Hours: 9:00-11:00am Monday-Friday (Teachers will be online and readily available.)
- Teachers know that flexibility will be key to helping students and parents during this school closure. It is understood that parents and students may need to set up appointments to connect with the teacher outside of the school day hours.

School to Home Communications

- Teachers will be using email as the main communication method with parents. Please check email daily for updates and information.
- Teachers may also call, or occasionally set up a Google Meeting online, if appropriate, to stay connected to students.
- Teachers will work together to avoid sending numerous emails throughout the week.

At Home Daily Learning Expectations

This approximate length of time should be used as a guide for students and families. This does not include reading time that is strongly encouraged or assigned at all grade levels.

- 4K: 30 minutes
- Gr 5K - Gr. 3: 60 minutes. (max 1 hour)
- Gr. 4 - Gr. 6: 90 minutes (max. 1.5 hours)
- Gr. 7-8: 120 minutes (max. 2 hours)
- Gr. 9-12: 180-240 minutes (max. 3-4 hours)

Attendance

Teachers will not be taking daily attendance. However, teachers will be checking in with students and families regularly to check on progress and offer assistance. Check-ins will happen via email and phone calls.

Student Chromebook Monitoring and Technology Support

School issued Chromebooks will continue to be monitored via Go Guardian. Students need to follow the school Technology Use agreement. Students who violate the agreement will have restrictions placed upon their Deerfield Google account/Chromebook and parents will be notified.
